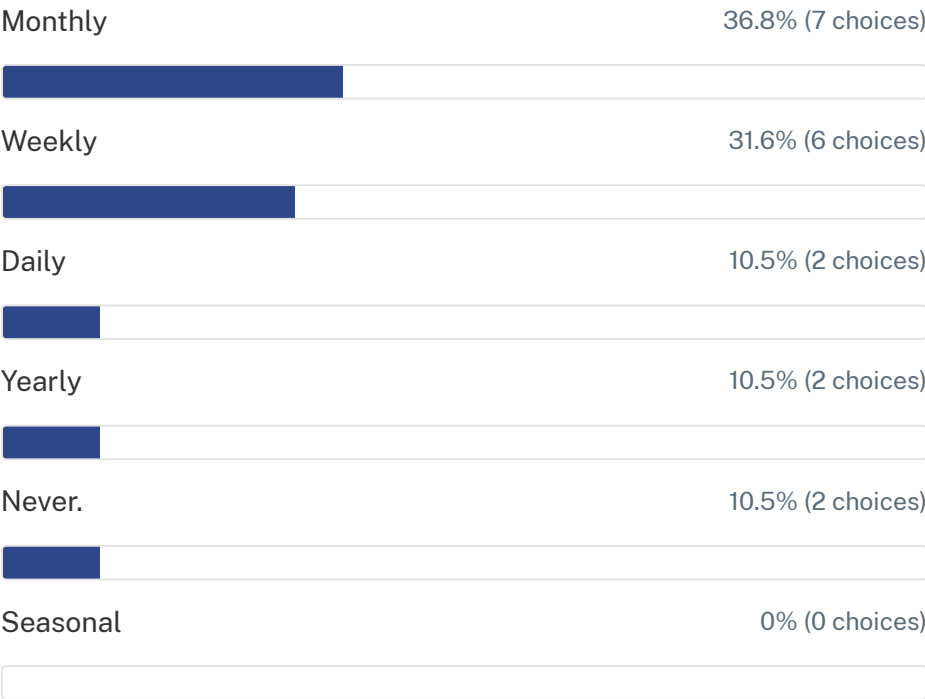

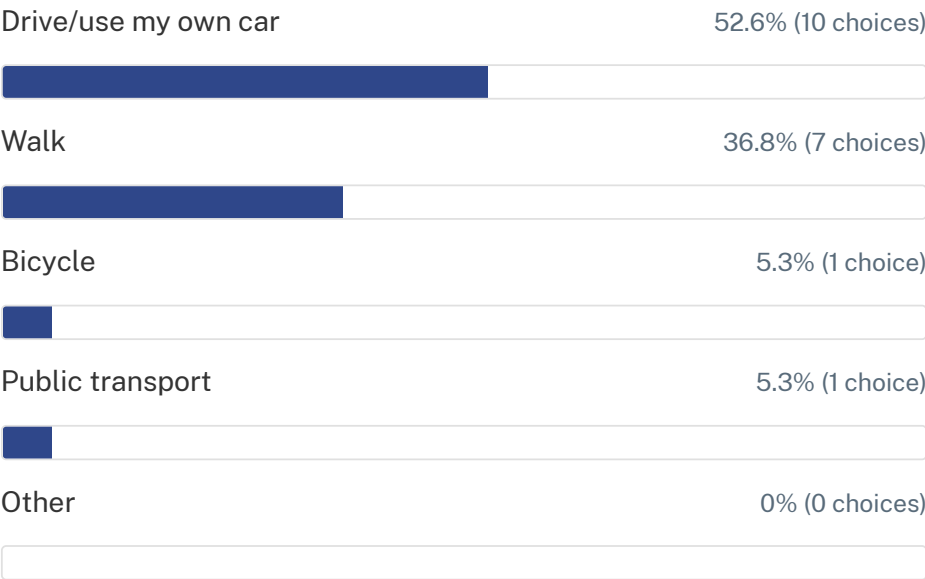
How often do you come to Kinneil Woods?

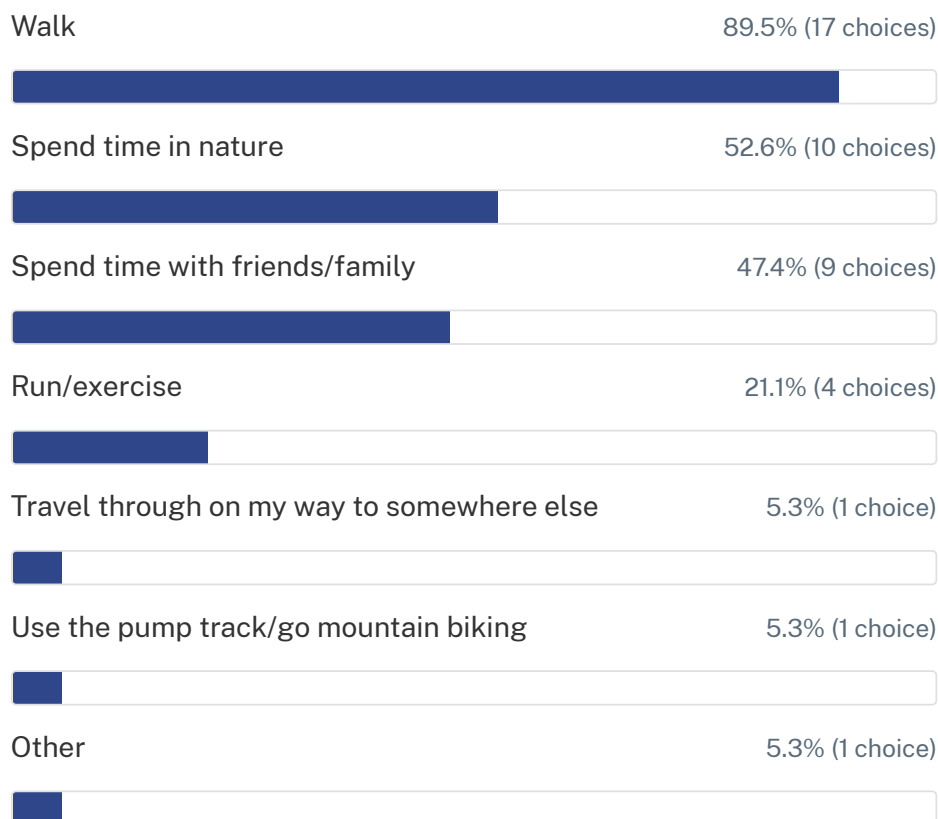
How do you get to Kinneil Woods?

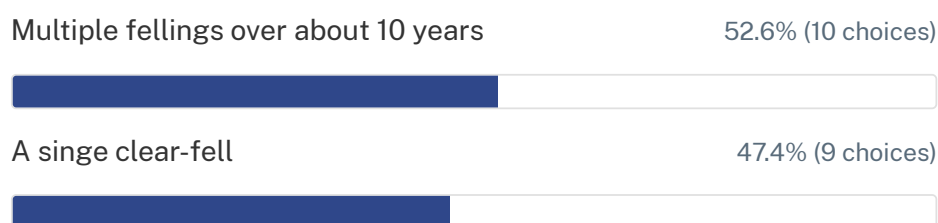
What do you like to do when visiting Kinneil Woods?

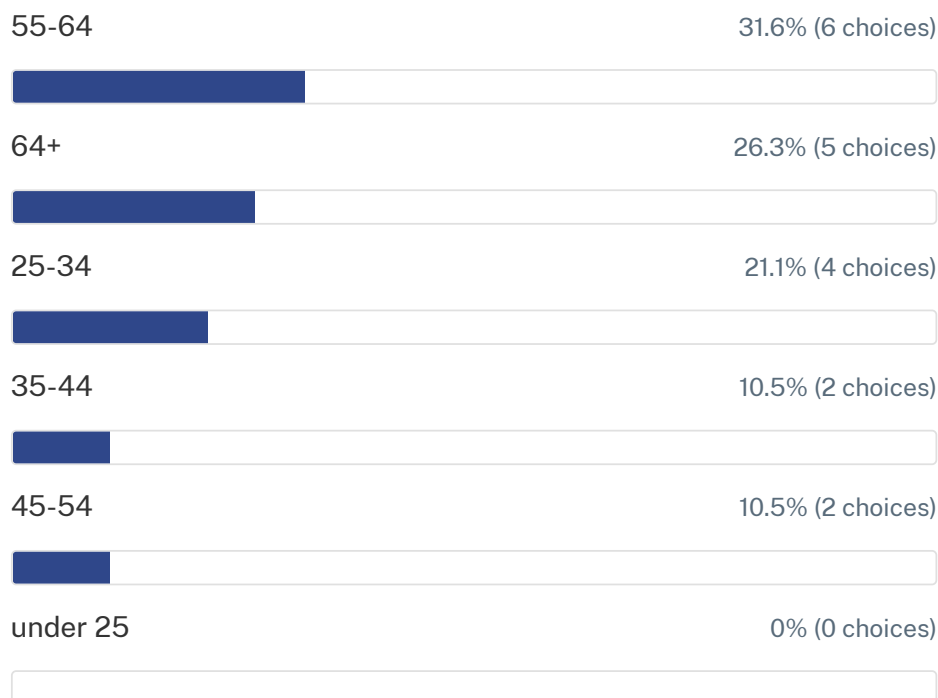

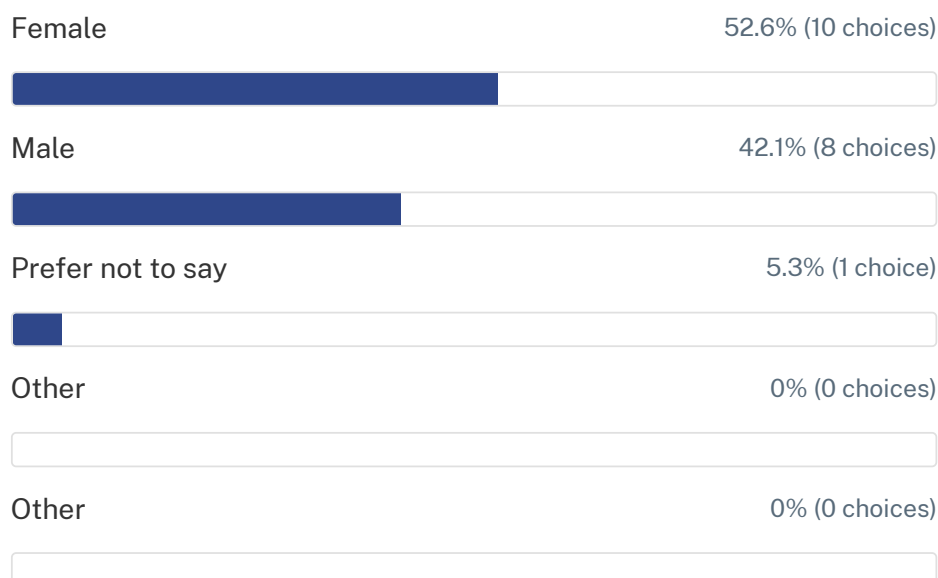


If there were an opportunity to carry out access improvements on this site - such as path improvements, additional seating areas and signage - what would you like to see improved.

The most frequently mentioned improvements were increased seating areas and benches and path improvements, particularly addressing overgrown, muddy, or washed-away paths. Some respondents suggested picnic areas and wildflower meadows as well as improved access from the town, such as transport links. Other suggestions included more poo bins cleaning or maintaining signage and measures to stop motorbikes using the site. A minority felt the current layout and facilities were adequate and well-balanced for their needs.
